


READY - sensitive language REgArDing disability for a more inclusive societY

READY aims at raising awareness among trainers and educators working with people with disabilities on the importance of the usage of a sensitive language as a tool to foster inclusion and equality and help to put an end to discrimination and stigmatization of people with disabilities.











TARGET GROUP

- READY project Target Group are trainers and educators working with people with disabilities. In many countries, teachers do not have the confidence or the necessary skills to deliver inclusive education.
- Teachers are often taught inclusion on the side rather than as a central principle of all the training they receive. Cooperation among trainers within institutions and organizations is also essential to support them in addressing diversity challenges.
- By involving them, partners can better study the different methods and tools implemented, co-design new ones and observe the immediate impact of this project in the everyday activities of the target group.

HOW TO GET TO VALENCIA?

BY PLANE

Valencia Airport is the tenth-busiest Spanish airport in terms of passengers and second in the region after Alicante. It is situated 8 km (5.0 mi) west of Valencia, in Manises. The airport has flight connections with about 20 European countries. The metro network Metrovalencia with lines 3 and 5 on the airport station, connects the airport to the city centre (I5 minutes), the main Railway Station of the city Estació del Nord (20 minutes) and the port of Valencia (30 minutes).

BY TRAIN

The city also has two main railway stations, the Estación del Norte, from which the local train network operates, and Joaquín Sorolla, offering AVE high-speed rail services to Madrid, Cuenca, Seville and Córdoba. ALVIA and EUROMED long-distance trains also depart from Joaquín Sorolla, providing connections to cities including Barcelona.

BY ROAD

The Mediterráneo AP-7 motorway, which runs the whole length of the Spanish Mediterranean coastline from north to south, connects with the European motorway network, the A-23 Sagunto- Somport motorway and the A-3 Madrid-València motorway.
